RESOLUTION NO. 19, SERIES 2012**

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 18, SERIES 2011, REPEALING
RESOLUTION NO. 19, SERIES 2006 AND AMENDING WATER AND WASTEWATER
CONNECTION FEES**

WHEREAS, Florence City Code Title 9, Chapter 2 provides for the City Council to set water and wastewater rate charges and to amend, or alter, from time to time, at the discretion of the Council by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the material, labor and equipment costs for the installation of water meters and wastewater connections increases each year; and

WHEREAS, the Florence City Council has reviewed information relative to the existing fees for water meter installation and wastewater connection and has determined that these fees should be adjusted annually for inflation or deflation, as a means of stabling future fee adjustments.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Florence City Council that Resolution No. 18, Series 2011 has been amended, Resolution No. 19, 2006 has been repealed, and that the following rates and fees are hereby established effective July 1, 2012 until the same shall be modified or amended by subsequent resolution of the City Council:

The fees shall be as follows:

<i>Water Connection Fees based on meter size and existing service to property line</i>	<i>Proposed Fee</i>
¾" Residential (w/ Premise Isolation)	\$790
¾" Commercial	\$600
1" Residential (w/ Premise Isolation)	\$950
1" Commercial	\$650
1 1/2-inch Meter	\$1,934
2-inch Meter	\$
2-inch Compound Meter	\$2,240
2-inch Turbo Meter with Strainer	\$1,775
Water Connection Fee if water main needs to be tapped	Meter connection fee plus time and materials
Water Connection Relocation Fee	\$200 plus time and materials

<i>Wastewater Connection Fee</i>	<i>Proposed Fee</i>
Residential & Commercial – stubbed to property line	\$200
Residential & Commercial – if unpaved street opening required	\$397
Residential & Commercial – if paved street opening required	\$798
Multi- Family – Same as above for first unit	
Multi – Family – for second unit	\$155
Multi-Family – per unit after second	\$103
Industrial	\$1,030
