

The Rhody Express operates on first the South Loop and then the North loop in a 70-minute circuit. If you are getting on in the South Loop and traveling to the North Loop or vice versa, just stay on the bus, you will reach your destination. Remember to be at the stop closest to you at the timepoint listed for the major stop before your stop (see inside for more instructions).

# **HOW TO CATCH THE BUS**

Bus stops are located every few blocks all along the route, except where the bus travels on Highway 101. Locate your nearest bus stop and wait there for the next bus. Additional instructions are included throughout this brochure

#### **OUR RHODY EXPRESS BUS**

The Rhody Express bus has capacity for 16 people seated facing forward. There also is room for people who use mobility devices, such as a wheelchair. The forward seats are designated for older adults and people with disabilities. A bike rack is on the front bumper on the bus with a capacity for two bicycles.

#### THE BUS IS ACCESSIBLE!

The Rhody Express vehicle is accessible to people who use mobility devices. The driver will assist with lift boarding and securement. Anyone can request use of the lift to board the bus.

#### HOW TO READ THE TIMETABLE

The route is divided into two loops — the North Loop and the South Loop. The timetable contains timepoints for major stops along the route. Find the closest timepoint to where you want to catch the bus. Read down that column of times to find the time that is most convenient for you. There are bus stops between timepoints, and riders should wait at their nearest bus stop according to the timepoint prior to their stop.

For instance, if you live on Spruce Street, south of 21st Street, you would look at the timepoint for the Grocery Outlet on the South Loop timetable, and arrive at your stop at the time noted for the Grocery Outlet. The bus will not leave the Grocery Outlet stop before the posted timepoint.

#### WHAT IF I CANNOT ACCESS THE BUS?

If you live within a three-quarter mile boundary of the bus route, and you cannot access the bus due to a disabling condition, the Rhody Express offers a curb-to-curb ADA paratransit service. Requests for this service are handled through the RideSource Call Center.

People requesting this service must participate in an in-person eligibility assessment performed by a transportation coordinator from the Lane Council of Governments, Senior Outreach program. Eligibility is based on a person's abilities to use the fixed-route Rhody Express service.
