Listed below are the 7-month stats of the Florence ADA (Americans with Disabilities) paratransit trips that are provided for people who live within a ¾-mile boundary of the Rhody Express who cannot use the fixed-route bus due to a disabling condition. As you can see, the expansion of the Rhody Express to serve the Casino to date has had no impact on the number of trips, which still average 73 per month. LTD will continue to monitor these trips and provide reports to the TAC.

FREE RIDE AGREEMENT

On the second Tuesday of every month between January 1, 2006, and December 31, 2006, Lane Transit District will offer free rides to all senior citizens, courtesy of Bi-Mart. Free rides apply to all regularly scheduled LTD routes.

1. **Term** - The term of this agreement shall be for the effective time period listed above. The agreement may be terminated at any time by mutual agreement or by either party giving at least thirty (30) days' written notice to the other party.

2. Conditions

Lane Transit District will provide the following:

Advertising

- Inclusion in LTD's Rider's Digest
- Two interior posters, to be placed in the buses and at the Eugene Transit Station for your business: one for your advertising purposes (artwork must be provided); and one as part of a joint promotion of the program
- Inclusion in joint promotions
- Inclusion in customized farebox cards
- An article in LTD's Bus Talk newsletter
- Press release to local media and area senior activity centers
- Distribution of fliers at LTD's Customer Service Center and at area senior activity centers
- Distribution of fliers at Bi-Mart

Free rides

- To Seniors 62 and older on the second Tuesday of each month between January 1, 2006, and December 31, 2006

Bi-Mart will provide the following:

Advertising

- Information consistent with provisions outlined in this agreement
- Distribution of fliers at Bi-Mart

Revenue

 Replacement of regular fare payments by senior citizens. Payment of \$225 is due for each free ride day. An invoice will be submitted to Bi-Mart on a monthly basis. Payment is due within ten (10) days of the monthly invoice.

- 3. **Default** If either party shall be in default in the performance of any provision of this agreement, and shall fail to cure such default within fifteen (15) days after receipt of written notice from the other party specifying the default, the aggrieved party shall be entitled to terminate this agreement.
- 4. **Route Exclusions** In the event the free senior day promotion results in passenger overloads, Lane Transit District reserves the right to exclude routes from the promotion. Notification of route exclusions will be communicated to Bi-Mart one (1) month prior to the implementation of any exclusions.
- 5. Hold Harmless LTD agrees to indemnify and hold Bi-Mart harmless from all liability on account of personal injury or property damage caused by or directly attributable to LTD's use or exercise of its agreement hereunder, including LTD's negligence, but excepting such injury or damage caused by Bi-Mart's negligence.
