Thank you for the opportunity to comment on your Draft TSP. ODA appreciates all City and County partnerships. My staff and I have reviewed your Draft TSP and would like to offer the following comments:

- After a brief review of the proposed Florence TSP update Air Plan (pages 138--144) including Exhibit B Policy Amendments and Exhibit C Proposed Amendments to Florence City Code Title 10, it appears that there is only one inconsistency between the proposed Florence TSP update and current ORS and OAR standards as referenced in Chapter 21, page 192 – FAA Form 7460-1 Notice of Proposed Construction or Alteration shall be reviewed by ODA as well as the FAA.
- Adding reference to ORS 836 relating to limitations on use to items 11 and 12 (page 144) should also be considered.
- The OAP 2007 should be referenced or recognized as well as the chapter specific to the Florence Municipal Airport that identifies possible projects in the Airport Capital Improvement Program (ACIP) in a broad sense (Section 4.1.c). The proposed Florence TSP identifies future projects based on the ACIP while providing greater detail to each specific capital improvement project. It may be beneficial for the city of Florence to add language or reference to ODA in items 15 and 16 under sub-heading Airport Master Plan Projects & Findings (page 144) for specific coordination with the OAP and forthcoming SCIP process.

Thanks for your call earlier this afternoon. I'll coordinate with you soon regarding noticing for the LCPC meeting on May 1st.

Regarding comments on the TSP Lane County appreciate the fact that you have incorporated our comments as w've reviewed this as part of the PMT meetings. As such, our comments have been well incorporated into the current draft. I offer the following for your consideration:

- On page 11 you indicate that the County no longer shares "timber payments" or "secure rural schools" monies. I'd clarify the secure rural schools expired this year and though we may receive a one year extension, this funding source is no longer available (on the bottom of the same page it states that we no longer receive SRS which is more accurate). Table 10-1 has another note regarding federal payments – assuming these are the same, I'd again clarify that we're no longer receiving those federal payments.
