 - b. Mail written comments to Florence City Hall, Attn: Budget Committee, 250 Hwy 101, Florence, OR 97439
 - c. Drop off written comments to the City of Florence drop box located at Florence City Hall (250 Hwy 101) during regular business hours (Monday through Friday 8 a.m. – Noon and 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.) or at the City of Florence drop box located at Florence City Hall to the right of the main entrance.
- ** Note:** Written comments received at least 2 hours prior to the meeting (May 5, 2025 at 3:30 p.m.) will be distributed to the Budget Committee, posted to the City of Florence website, and made part of the record.
2. Verbal Testimony: Verbal testimony will be taken at May 12th and May 14th Budget Committee meetings. Citizens wishing to express their views to the Budget Committee may participate in the meeting in person or via GotoWebinar. To do so, please complete a speaker's card online at <https://www.ci.florence.or.us/bc-bc/request-address-budget-committee-speakers-card> at least 1 hour prior to the meeting. City staff will then contact the speaker to let them know the process to participate in the meeting. Verbal comments will be allowed during the public hearing items after staff has given their report and have allowed time for initial Budget Committee questions. Comments are limited to five minutes per person with no limit on the number of speakers.
