
ePermits Training


Building Permit Technician Eric Rines and Dependahl attended a one-day training and conference with regarding the ePermits system. The event was held at Building Code Division of the Department of Labor and Industries offices in Salem on March 29th. It was a good exchange of information and answered many questions about the system we now are using to record and issue permits.

Driftwood Shores

The storm of Jan 18, 2012 caused much damage at the Driftwood Shores Resort. After investigation and review of the extent of the damage, it has been determined that some of the existing electrical system will be replaced in addition to a new roof and damaged exterior components due to water damage. In addition, Buildings E & F are required to have automatic fire sprinklers installed due to the valuation of the repairs required to comply with the Oregon Fire and Building Codes. The cost of the damage is estimated at in excess of \$1 million in addition to the initial removal of wet materials and drying of the structure. Fire Marshal Sean Barrett and Chief Electrical Inspector Don Meier were of great help in identifying these issues. We worked to bring the Resort and their Insurer together to explain code issues and help guide the process. Permit applications are now forthcoming.
