

Council in Crisis!

- 1. Oregon state law banning candidate Mark Hoffman from appearing on the presidential ballot b/c he didn't qualify under state law.
- 2. Florence Anti-Fascists have formed.
- 3. They are demanding that the Mayor of Florence direct city staff to disregard and:
 - Provide ballots with Hoffman's name on them.
 - Sue the state to put Hoffman's name on the ballot state wide.
 - State legislators for Florence introduce legislation to undo the state law.
- 4. If he does not they say they will "see to it that he is removed from office".
- 5. They have given the city one week to publicly announce their plans to comply.
- 6. The leader of this group is "Smash Siuslaw".
- 7. By Monday morning, the petition has 16,500 signatures.

Breaking News!

- NBC has video of Chief Pitcher saying he agrees with the petition.
- She's called the Mayor and council members and CM Wantz has agreed to appear.

Breaking News!

- Mayor is back in town for the council meeting and members of FAF are demanding a written progress report on their demands from the city. They were unsatisfied with 3 mins at the microphone.
- During a vote , they demand to speak again and members of the group approach the dias chanting, "Free Mark" one of them goes behind the council members and unfurls a banner that says, "Free Mark!"

Big Bowl Questions

- 1. What does a community vision for the future mean to you?
- 2. If a visioning process is undertaken, should the City partner with another entity/entities?
- 3. What are the outcomes or "ends" that you hope to achieve by having a vision for the community (how would you use it)?
- 4. Should the City continue to explore undertaking a community visioning process?

Group Work

What is Community Visioning? There are three important components:

- The process itself collaborating with all segments of the community in order to understand what they want their community to be in the future that is both aspirational and forward thinking.
- Creation of a Vision Statement(s)
- Make it real by incorporating the results into a set of strategic priorities, comprehensive plans, work plans, budget, etc.

Other Questions to Consider

1. How extensively do you want to engage the community during the process?

2. What might be challenges to undertaking a visioning process (staff and financial resources)?

3. What might be the timing for undertaking a community visioning process?

4. How does undertaking a Community Attitude Survey fit into the visioning process (is it the first step)?
