

**CITY OF FLORENCE
RESOLUTION NO. 22, SERIES 2019**

A Resolution Establishing Approval to Apply for a 2019 Materials Management Grant from the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality and Delegating Authority to the City Manager or Designee to sign the application

RECITALS:

1. The Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) is accepting grant applications for the 2019 Materials Management Grant Program.
2. The City of Florence desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of improving our biosolids composting operations through the purchase of a reel mixer.
3. DEQ has developed a list of criteria that places emphasis on projects that reduce waste, promote reuse or recover of waste through recycling, composting or anaerobic digestion.
4. The City of Florence has available local matching funds to fulfill its share of obligation related to this grant application should the grant funds be awarded.
5. The City of Florence will provide adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of this equipment should the grant funds be awarded.


Based on these findings,
