

**CITY OF FLORENCE  
RESOLUTION NO. 2, SERIES 2019**

**A Resolution Authorizing the City of Florence, Oregon to Accept a Grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Program for the Enhanced Crossing, and Sidewalk for Siuslaw Elementary School Students Preoject**

RECITALS:

1. The Oregon Department of Transportation is awarding the City of Florence a Safe Routes to School grant.
2. The City of Florence desires to accept this grant in order to provide needed pedestrian and bicycle safety improvements along 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> streets between Hwy 101 and Oak Street; installation of a Rectangular Rapid Flash Beacon midblock Hwy 101 between 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> streets; and completion of the pedestrian and bicycle path within the Pine Street right-of-way between 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> streets.
3. The City of Florence has available local matching funds to fulfill its share of obligation related to this grant award.
4. The City of Florence will provide adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of these facilities.


Based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Authorizes the City Manager to accept the Oregon Department of Transportation Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Competitive Infrastructure Program grant to complete pedestrian and bicycle safety improvements along 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> streets between Hwy 101 and Oak Street; installation of a Rectangular Rapid Flash Beacon midblock Hwy 101 between 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> streets; and completion of the pedestrian and bicycle path within the Pine Street right-of-way between 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> streets.
2. This Resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.
