

**CITY OF FLORENCE
ORDINANCE NO. 1, SERIES 2020**

**An Ordinance amending Florence City Code Title 7, Chapter 1 Parking Violations,
Related to Parking Citation Operator Response Deadlines**

Recitals:

1. The City of Florence needs to amend its parking citation code to align with new legislation passed by the Oregon House of Representatives HB 2471, implemented under ORS 221.333.

THE CITY OF FLORENCE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Florence City Code Chapter 1 of Title 7 is amended as shown in Exhibit A.
2. This Ordinance shall become effective 30 days after adoption.
3. The City Recorder is authorized to administratively correct any reference errors contained herein or in other provisions of the Florence City Code to the provisions added, amended, or repealed herein.



FLORENCE CITY CODE

TITLE 7 MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

CHAPTER 1 TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

7-1-7-9: PARKING CITATIONS:

A. Citation on Illegally Parked Vehicle: Whenever a vehicle without an operator is found parked in violation of a restriction imposed by this Title or State law, the officer finding the vehicle shall take its license number and any other information displayed on the vehicle which may identify its owner, and shall conspicuously affix to the vehicle a traffic citation instructing the operator to answer to the charge ~~against him or pay the penalty imposed within five (5) days~~ during the hours and at a place specified in the citation.

B. Failure to Comply with Citation: If the operator does not respond to a traffic citation affixed to a vehicle ~~within a period of five (5) days~~, the Court clerk may send to the owner of the vehicle to which the traffic citation was affixed a letter informing the owner of the violation and warning him that in the event that the letter is disregarded for a period of ~~five (5) fourteen (14) days~~, a warrant for the arrest of the owner will be issued. the case may be sent to collections.
