

**CITY OF FLORENCE  
RESOLUTION NO. 26, SERIES 2020**

**A Resolution Establishing Approval to Apply for a Grant from the Oregon Department of Aviation for Improvements at the Airport, and Delegating Authority to the City Manager or Designee to Sign the Application.**

RECITALS:

1. The Oregon Department of Aviation is accepting grant applications for the Critical Oregon Airport Relief (COAR) Grant Program.
2. The City of Florence desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing a replacement to the 20-year old Automated Weather Observation System (AWOS).
3. City Council and staff members have identified the necessity to replace the AWOS in the 5-year Airport Capital Improvement Plan.
4. The City of Florence has available local matching funds to fulfill its share of obligation related to this grant application should the grant funds be awarded.
5. The City of Florence will provide adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of this facility should the grant funds be awarded.


Based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council demonstrates its support for the submittal of a grant application to the Oregon Department of Aviation for Critical Oregon Airport Relief (COAR) grant program for the replacement of the Automated Weather Observation System (AWOS) at the Florence Municipal Airport.
2. This Resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.
