

**CITY OF FLORENCE
RESOLUTION NO. 2, SERIES 2020**

A Resolution Establishing Approval to Apply for a Grant from the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department for Construction and Development of the Airport Memorial Gateway Project, and Delegating Authority to the City Manager or Designee to Sign the Application.

RECITALS:

1. The Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting grant applications for the Veterans' and War Memorials Grant Program.
2. The City of Florence desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of creating an Airport Memorial Gateway honoring all veterans during times of war and peace.
3. City Council, Staff and members of Deeds of Valor have identified the desired improvements to create an Airport Memorial Gateway.
4. The Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 3232 is committed to partnering with the City on the Airport Memorial Gateway Project, as is the Florence chapters of the American Legion and Disabled American Veterans.
5. The City of Florence has available local matching funds to fulfill its share of obligation related to this grant application should the grant funds be awarded.
6. The City of Florence will provide adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of this facility should the grant funds be awarded.


Based on these findings,
