

**CITY OF FLORENCE
RESOLUTION NO. 31, SERIES 2020**

A Resolution Authorizing the City of Florence, Oregon to Accept a Grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Program for the Improved Crossing and Crosswalks for Siuslaw Middle School Students Project

RECITALS:

1. The Oregon Department of Transportation is awarding the City of Florence a Safe Routes to School grant.
2. The City of Florence desires to accept this grant in order to provide needed pedestrian safety improvements along Oak Street between 21st and 34th streets which includes the replacement, and in a number of locations the realignment of curb ramps, at the street intersections.
3. The City of Florence has available local matching funds to fulfill its share of obligation related to this grant award.
4. The City of Florence will provide adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of these facilities.

Based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Authorizes the City Manager to accept the Oregon Department of Transportation Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Competitive Infrastructure Program grant to complete pedestrian safety improvements along Oak Street between 21st and 34th streets.
2. This Resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.
