

**CITY OF FLORENCE
RESOLUTION NO. 3, SERIES 2021**

A Resolution adopting appropriations for pass-through grant funding and expenditure to support the Florence Emergency Cold Weather Shelter (FECWS) Pallet Shelter Program

RECITALS:

1. Certain needs have arisen that could not be foreseen during the biennium that require adjustment to the 2019-2021 biennium budget appropriations, and;
2. ORS 294.471 allows for one or more supplemental budgets for a pressing necessity that could not reasonably be foreseen when preparing the original budget or previous supplemental budgets for the current year or current budget period and that requires prompt action.
3. As presented to the City Council at the November 16, 2020 and January 25, 2021 Meetings, the City is in receipt of pass-through CARES ACT Grant funding from Lane County with a related expenditure to support the Florence Emergency Cold Weather Shelter (FECWS) Pallet Shelter Program.

Based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


1. The City Council of the City of Florence approves the following appropriation adjustments for the 2019-2021 Biennium:

Revenues Intergovernmental \$31,000	Expenditures Non-Departmental \$31,000
