

**CITY OF FLORENCE
RESOLUTION NO. 14, SERIES 2022**

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING APPROVAL TO APPLY FOR A GRANT IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$75,000 FROM THE OREGON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT
FOR REPLACING CERTAIN PLAYGROUND STRUCTURES AT MILLER PARK, AND
DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO SIGN THE
GRANT APPLICATION**

RECITALS:

1. The Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the Local Government Grant Program.
2. The City of Florence desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed park and recreation improvements and enhancements.
3. City Council and Staff members have identified the necessity to replace the 35-year-old wooden play structure at Miller Park.
4. The City of Florence has available local matching funds to fulfill its share of obligation related to this grant application should the grant funds be awarded.
5. The City of Florence will provide adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of this park and recreation facility should the grant funds be awarded.

Based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council demonstrates its support for the submittal of a grant application in the amount of \$75,000 to the Oregon Park and Recreation Department for Local Government Grant Program for demolition of an existing play structure; installation of a new and inclusive play structure; and other improvements at Miller Park
2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


