CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLUTION NO. 19, SERIES 2022

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CITY'S ELECTION TO RECEIVE STATE SHARED REVENUES.

RECITALS:

- The State of Oregon revised statutes (ORS) 221.770 require that a city may not be included in apportionments to receive distributions of State Revenue Sharing unless it elects to receive distributions by enactment of an ordinance or resolution expressing that election.
- 2. As required by ORS 221.770, a public hearing before the Budget Committee was held on the 10th day of May, 2021, and a public hearing before the City Council was held on the 20th day of June, 2022, giving citizens an opportunity to comment on the use of State Revenue Sharing for the 2022 2023 fiscal year.

Based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Pursuant to ORS 221.770, the City of Florence hereby elects to receive state revenues for the 2022 2023 fiscal year.
- 2. This Resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.
