

**CITY OF FLORENCE  
RESOLUTION NO. 20, SERIES 2022**

**A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE CITY'S ELIGIBILITY TO RECEIVE STATE-  
SHARED REVENUES.**

RECITALS:

1. State Revenue Sharing Law, ORS 221.760, provides as follows:
  - a. Section 1: The officer responsible for disbursing funds to cities under ORS 323.455, 366.280 to 366.785, and 471.805 shall, in the case of a city located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants according to the most recent federal decennial census, disburse such funds only if the city provides four or more of the following services:
    - i. Police protection
    - ii. Fire protection
    - iii. Street construction, maintenance, and lighting
    - iv. Sanitary sewer
    - v. Storm sewers
    - vi. Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
    - vii. One or more utility services
2. The City of Florence provides four or more of the required municipal services enumerated in section 1, ORS 221.760 and will be in operation for the duration of the 2022-23 fiscal year.

Based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


1. The City of Florence is eligible to receive State Shared Revenues for the 2022-23 fiscal year.
2. This Resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.
