## CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLUTION NO. 20, SERIES 2022

## A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE CITY'S ELIGIBILITY TO RECEIVE STATE-SHARED REVENUES.

## RECITALS:

- 1. State Revenue Sharing Law, ORS 221.760, provides as follows:
  - a. Section 1: The officer responsible for disbursing funds to cities under ORS 323.455, 366.280 to 366.785, and 471.805 shall, in the case of a city located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants according to the most recent federal decennial census, disburse such funds only if the city provides four or more of the following services:
    - i. Police protection
    - ii. Fire protection
    - iii. Street construction, maintenance, and lighting
    - iv. Sanitary sewer
    - v. Storm sewers
    - vi. Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
    - vii. One or more utility services
- 2. The City of Florence provides four or more of the required municipal services enumerated in section 1, ORS 221.760 and will be in operation for the duration of the 2022-23 fiscal year.

Based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City of Florence is eligible to receive State Shared Revenues for the 2022-23 fiscal year.
- 2. This Resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.
