

**CITY OF FLORENCE
RESOLUTION NO. 28, SERIES 2022**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FLORENCE, OREGON TO ACCEPT A
BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE LAW (BIL) GRANT FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION
ADMINISTRATION FOR PAVEMENT REHABILITATION AT FLORENCE MUNICIPAL
AIRPORT**

RECITALS:

1. The Federal Aviation Administration is awarding the City of Florence a Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) grant.
2. The City of Florence desires to accept this grant program in order to complete engineering design and construction services for the Pavement Rehabilitation Project
3. City Council and staff members have identified the necessity to perform pavement rehabilitation of the runway, taxiway, apron and taxi-lanes in the 5-year Airport Capital Improvement Plan.
4. The Pavement Rehabilitation Project for the runway, taxiway, apron and taxi-lanes is a funded project included in the 2021-2026 SCIP (Statewide Capital Improvement Program)
5. The City of Florence will provide adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of this facility.

Based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Authorizes the City Manager to accept the BIL grant from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for the Pavement Rehabilitation of the runway, taxiway, apron and taxi-lanes.
2. Authorizes the City Manager to enter into the grant offer from the FAA as the Airport Sponsor.
3. This Resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.

This Resolution is passed and adopted on the 12th day of September, 2022.
