# A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FLORENCE, OREGON TO ACCEPT A BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE LAW (BIL) GRANT FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION FOR PAVEMENT REHABILITATION AT FLORENCE MUNICIPAL AIRPORT

#### RECITALS:

- 1. The Federal Aviation Administration is awarding the City of Florence a Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) grant.
- 2. The City of Florence desires to accept this grant program in order to complete engineering design and construction services for the Pavement Rehabilitation Project
- City Council and staff members have identified the necessity to perform pavement rehabilitation of the runway, taxiway, apron and taxi-lanes in the 5-year Airport Capital Improvement Plan.
- 4. The Pavement Rehabilitation Project for the runway, taxiway, apron and taxi-lanes is a funded project included in the 2021-2026 SCIP (Statewide Capital Improvement Program)
- 5. The City of Florence will provide adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of this facility.

Based on these findings,

### THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Authorizes the City Manager to accept the BIL grant from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for the Pavement Rehabilitation of the runway, taxiway, apron and taxi-lanes.
- 2. Authorizes the City Manager to enter into the grant offer from the FAA as the Airport Sponsor.
- 3. This Resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.
