A RESOLUTION REPREALING RESOLUTION NO. 16, SERIES 2019, AND ADJUSTING THE CITY OF FLORENCE'S FEES AND CHARGES FOR SERVICES

RECITALS:

- 1. Resolution No. 16, Series 2019 updated fees and charges for fiscal year 2019-20.
- 2. Rates have not been increased since July 1, 2019 to assist residents affected by the Covid-19 pandemic.
- 3. The fee schedule in exhibit A provides methodologies for rates and fees. Where methodologies are unclear, the most recent resolution and/or ordinance establishing the fees and charges may be used to clarify the methodology.
- 4. Consistent with the City's adopted fiscal policies, the City Manager caused a review of certain fees and charges.
- 5. Based upon the review, fees and charges for City services were determined to require adjustment to recover costs associated with those services.
- 6. The City Budget Committee approved and the City Council adopted the biennial 2021-23 budget with adjustments to the fees and charges for services, as described in Exhibit A

Based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The fees and charges for services for the City of Florence are hereby established as set forth in Exhibit A, attached to and made a part of Resolution 8, Series 2022.
- 2. This Resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption, with changes to certain fees and charges as described in Exhibit A effective as of April 1, 2022.
