RESOLUTION NO. 8, SERIES 2023**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FLORENCE, OREGON TO ACCEPT A
CRITICAL OREGON AIRPORT RELIEF PROGRAM GRANT FROM THE OREGON
DEPARTMENT OF AVIATION FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT THE FLORENCE MUNICIPAL
AIRPORT**

RECITALS:

1. The Oregon Department of Aviation is awarding the City of Florence a Critical Oregon Airport Relief (COAR) Program grant.
2. The City of Florence desires to accept this grant program in order to provide airport runway, taxiway, apron and taxi lane pavement rehabilitation improvements.
3. City Council and staff members have identified the necessity for the pavement rehabilitation project in the 5-year Airport Capital Improvement Plan and in the FY2021-23 Biennium Capital Improvement Plan.
4. The runway, taxiway, apron and taxi lane pavement rehabilitation is a funded project included in the 2018-2023 SCIP (Statewide Capital Improvement Program).
5. The City of Florence has available local matching funds to fulfill its share of obligation related to this grant award.
6. The City of Florence will provide adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of this facility should the grant funds be awarded.

Based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Authorizes the City Manager or designee to accept the Critical Oregon Airport Relief (COAR) grant from the Oregon Department of Aviation (ODA) for the runway, taxiway, apron and taxi lane pavement rehabilitation improvements at the Florence Municipal Airport.
2. This Resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.
