**A RESOLUTION RATIFYING STAFFS DECISION TO APPLY FOR A CONGRESSIONAL
DIRECT SPENDING FUND REQUEST AND AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER OR
DESIGNEE TO SIGN THE GRANT APPLICATION**

RECITALS:

1. The United States Senate Committee on Appropriations was accepting applications for the Congressional Directed Spending (CDS) funds through March 3, 2023.
2. The City of Florence desired to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing funding for the Siuslaw River Slope Stabilization Project.
3. The City of Florence has available local matching funds to fulfill its share of obligation related to this grant application should the grant funds be awarded.
4. The City of Florence will provide adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of the slope repairs should the grant funds be awarded.

Based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council demonstrates its support of staff's decision to submit a grant application to the United States Senate Committee on Appropriations for Congressional Directed Spending (CDS) funds to address the Siuslaw River Slope Stabilization Project.
2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


