

**CITY OF FLORENCE
RESOLUTION NO. 10, SERIES 2017**

A Resolution Certifying the City's Eligibility to Receive State-Shared Revenues.

RECITALS:

1. State Revenue Sharing Law, ORS 221.760, provides as follows:
 - a. Section 1: The officer responsible for disbursing funds to cities under ORS 323.455, 366.785 to 366.280 and 471.805 shall, in the case of a city located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants according to the most recent federal decennial census, disburse such funds only if the city provides four or more of the following services:
 - i. Police Protection
 - ii. Fire Protection
 - iii. Street construction, maintenance, and lighting
 - iv. Sanitary Sewer
 - v. Storm Sewers
 - vi. Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
 - vii. One or more utility services

Based on these findings,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council of the City of Florence hereby certifies that it provides the following municipal services, which is four or more or the municipal services enumerated in section 1, ORS 221.760:
 - i) Police Protection
 - ii) Street construction, maintenance, and lighting
 - iii) Sanitary Sewer
 - iv) Storm Sewers
 - v) Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
 - vi) One or more utility services
2. This Resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.
