CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLUTION NO. 24, SERIES 2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FLORENCE, OREGON TO ENTER INTO A SINGLE SOURCE PURCHASE AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$149,005 WITH DELL EMC, INC. TO PURCHASE THE VXRAIL SERVER SOLUTION

RECITALS:

- 1. The Information Technology Department has researched and determined the need to implement the enhanced IT Infrastructure recommendations per the IT Report produced in April 2017 by GEL Oregon, and per recommendations by DELL EMC.
- 2. Staff has determined that only one supplier/one source is sufficiently familiar with the City's existing system supplier to provide support.
- 3. The City is currently standardized on DELL computer servers and workstations.
- 4. The system as proposed by DELL EMC will result in substantial total cost (TCO) savings to the City by utilizing existing hardware and software, minimization of downtime and training, and insures the safety/function of the systems both during and following the implementation.
- 5. That funding is available in FY18 Adopted Budget.

Based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Manager is authorized to proceed and enter into the Purchase Agreement between DELL EMC and the City of Florence, Oregon in the amount of \$149,005 for the purchase of the 4-node VxRail Hyper-Converged server solution.
