CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLUTION NO. 8, SERIES 2014

A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION 12, SERIES 2013 AND AMENDING WATER AND WASTEWATER CONNECTION FEES

WHEREAS, Florence City Code Title 9, Chapter 2 provides for the City Council to set water and wastewater rate charges and to amend, or alter, from time to time, at the discretion of the Council by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the material, labor and equipment costs for the installation of water meters and wastewater connections increases each year; and

WHEREAS, the material costs for \(^3\)4-inch; 1-inch; 1 \(^1\)2-inch and 2-inch meters have decreased, with the exception of the 2-inch turbo meter; and

WHEREAS, the Florence City Council has reviewed information relative to the existing fees for water meter installation and wastewater connection and has determined that these fees should be adjusted annually for inflation or deflation, as a means of stabling future fee adjustments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Florence City Council that Resolution No. 12, Series 2013 has been repealed, and that the following rates and fees are hereby established effective July 1, 2014 until the same shall be modified or amended by subsequent resolution of the City Council:
