

**CITY OF FLORENCE
RESOLUTION NO. 16, SERIES 2018**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FLORENCE, OREGON TO ENTER INTO A SINGLE SOURCE AGREEMENT WITH REBUILD-IT SERVICES GROUP IN THE AMOUNT OF \$70,619 TO REBUILD A WALKER DRIVE UNIT FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT CLARIFIER.

RECITALS:

1. Public Works has researched and determined the need to complete a total rebuild of the Walker Dive unit of the clarifier at the Wastewater Treatment Plant.
2. Rebuild-it Services Group is the only specialized rebuild companies for Walker Drive units in the Pacific Northwest.
3. Funding is available in the FY17-19 Adopted Budget from the Wastewater Capital Outlay Fund.


Based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Manager is authorized to proceed and enter into Purchase Agreement between Rebuild-it Services Group and the City of Florence, Oregon in the amount of \$70,619 to remove, rebuild, reassemble, and reinstall the Walker Drive unit for one of the clarifiers at the City Wastewater Treatment Plant.
