CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLUTION NO. 9, SERIES 2015

A Resolution Approving Application for Transportation and Growth Management Program Funds

RECITALS:

- 1. The Oregon Department of Transportation is accepting applications for the Transportation and Growth Management (TGM) Program and the City of Florence desires to participate in this funding program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed updates to the City's transportation planning documents.
- 2. Grant application to TGM demonstrates a need for these updates in order to meet the following objectives:
 - Incorporate the Confederated Tribes of the Coos, Lower Umpqua and Siuslaw Indians' as a transit provider in the Florence area
 - Identify connectivity for the Florence to Yachats Transit connection
 - Coordinate the proposed pedestrian, bike, and transit projects into cohesive innovative projects, providing connectivity and enhancing local circulation.
 - Create transit facility improvement standards to address parking reduction trade-off code and incorporate a unified city-wide theme.
 - Redesign major transit stops to include safe and appealing multi-modal functionality.
 - Update the Access Management Plan and develop an Old Town Parking Plan.
- 3. The update of the Transit and Access Management Plans and development of an Old Town Parking Plan will address growth projections and land use patterns planned in the updated Florence Realization 2020 Comprehensive Plan, providing more feasible growth management and facility planning tools.

Based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City of Florence supports application for TGM funds from the Oregon Department of Transportation to update the Transit Plan, as specified above.
