CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLUTION NO. 2, SERIES 2016

A Resolution Establishing Approval to Apply for a Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant from the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department for Land Acquisition and Development to Create South Rhododendron Beach/River Park, and Delegating Authority to the City Manager or Designee to Sign the Application.

RECITALS:

- 1. The Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant Program.
- 2. The City of Florence desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed park and recreation acquisitions, improvements and enhancements.
- 3. City Council, Staff, and Community members have identified Open Space and Non-Motorized Trails as high priority need in the Florence Parks and Recreation Master Plan of 2011.
- 4. Acquisition of lands as necessary to support the goals and objectives of the master plan, and specifically, waterfront and estuary access is a recommended priority in the Florence Parks and Recreation Master Plan of 2011.
- 5. The City of Florence has available local matching funds to fulfill its share of obligation related to this grant application should the grant funds be awarded.
- 6. The City of Florence will provide adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of this park and recreation facility should the grant funds be awarded.

Based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council demonstrates its support for the submittal of a grant application to the Oregon Park and Recreation Department for Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant to acquire and develop South Rhododendron Beach/River Park.
- 2. This Resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.
