



Transportation System Plan Update

LATEST NEWS AND UPDATES

The City of Florence is updating its Transportation System Plan (TSP), the long-range planning document that guides transportation policies and investments in the City. At this stage, the City has forecasted future traffic volumes, evaluated future traffic conditions, and developed and evaluated alternatives to address gaps and deficiencies in the existing transportation system and needs to accommodate growth in the City. The City has prepared a series of technical memorandums to document each step, including:

MEMO 4: FUTURE TRAFFIC CONDITIONS

This memo presents future transportation system conditions with no improvements constructed. The information provided is based on population and employment forecasts and corresponding growth in traffic volumes throughout the City. The future deficiencies identified in this memo serve as the basis for developing transportation system alternatives and improvement projects for the TSP update.

Future Challenges:

- Traffic volumes
- Delay at intersections
- Safety issues
- Traffic stress
- Parking demand

MEMO 5: ALTERNATIVES ANALYSIS

This memo presents potential solutions that are based on what we learn from conversations with the community and from needs identified in the existing and future conditions analysis. The final plan will include a prioritized list of improvements that reflects community needs, and that the city can pursue over time.

Transportation System Alternatives

- Changes in street classifications
- Street connections and extensions
- Intersection traffic control and configuration
- Sidewalks, crosswalks, shared-use paths, and trails
- Bike lanes, shared lanes, and bicycle boulevards
- Transit service, transit stop upgrades, and park-and-rides
- Local freight route designations
- Safe Routes to School strategies
- Safety enhancements for intersections and roadways
- Local street connections and extensions
- Emerging transportation technologies
- Parking management strategies
- Funding for future transportation improvements
