Florence Oregon Pickleball Club recommendations to the renovations at Rolling Dunes Park

- Construct 2 New courts in expansion area with 10' High Perimeter Fence with wind stop fabric,
  4' high dividing fencing, permanent nets and multi-color paint
- 2) Build 5' wide walkway with weatherproof benches and paddle racks between new court and old courts
- 3) Install 8 -10' high dividing fence between east and west tennis courts with wind block fabric
- 4) Convert east tennis court to 4 permanent pickleball courts with 4' high dividing fencing and permanent nets and multi-color paint
- 5) Paint blended lines over West Tennis court for 2-4 pickleball courts. These will be used for overflow or tournaments with portable nets.
- 6) Add gravel with weed blocker or concrete perimeter around all courts to prevent intrusion of weeds or dirt and allow access through other gates.
- 7) Leave existing east fence and add wind block fabric.
- 8) If noise is an issue, add sound deadening matts to perimeter fences. They are shown to reduce noise levels by up to 10 decibels.
- 9) Space for players to change in the bathrooms.
- 10) A Water bottle filling station.
- 11) Space to store portable nets and equipment.
- 12) Outlets to plug in a ball machine for both tennis and pickleball courts
- 13) Weatherproof Backboard for Tennis and Pickleball Practice
- 14) Install bark mulch or gravel walking path through park
