I hereby RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS the City of Florence, the Florence Police Department, and their employees, and authorized representatives from any and all claims for damage or injury to myself, my family, my estate, or my heirs or assigns, arising out of or involving my participation in the Citizen Ride-Along Observer Program.			
I am of lawful age and legally competent to sign this release. I fully understand the terms of the release and comprehend that the terms of this agreement will affect my ability to sue the City, the Police Department, or their authorized representatives.

## FLORENCE POLICE DEPARTMENT CITIZEN OBSERVER PROGRAM RULES OF CONDUCT

## RIDERS SHALL BE REQUIRED TO COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING RULES:

- 1. Riders shall be dressed in appropriate attire. Shorts, tank tops or halter tops are not appropriate attire while riding as an observer.
- 2. Riders shall not carry any firearm or concealed weapon during their tour.
- 3. Riders shall not be under the influence of or affected by any intoxicants, drugs or medication.
- 4. Riders shall at all times follow directions of the officers they are assigned to and not interfere or distract the officer in the performance of his/her official duties.
- 5. For the safety of officers and citizens of the community, the shift sergeant or acting supervisor may at any time terminate a rider from the program, either for inappropriate conduct or circumstances which may require such action.
