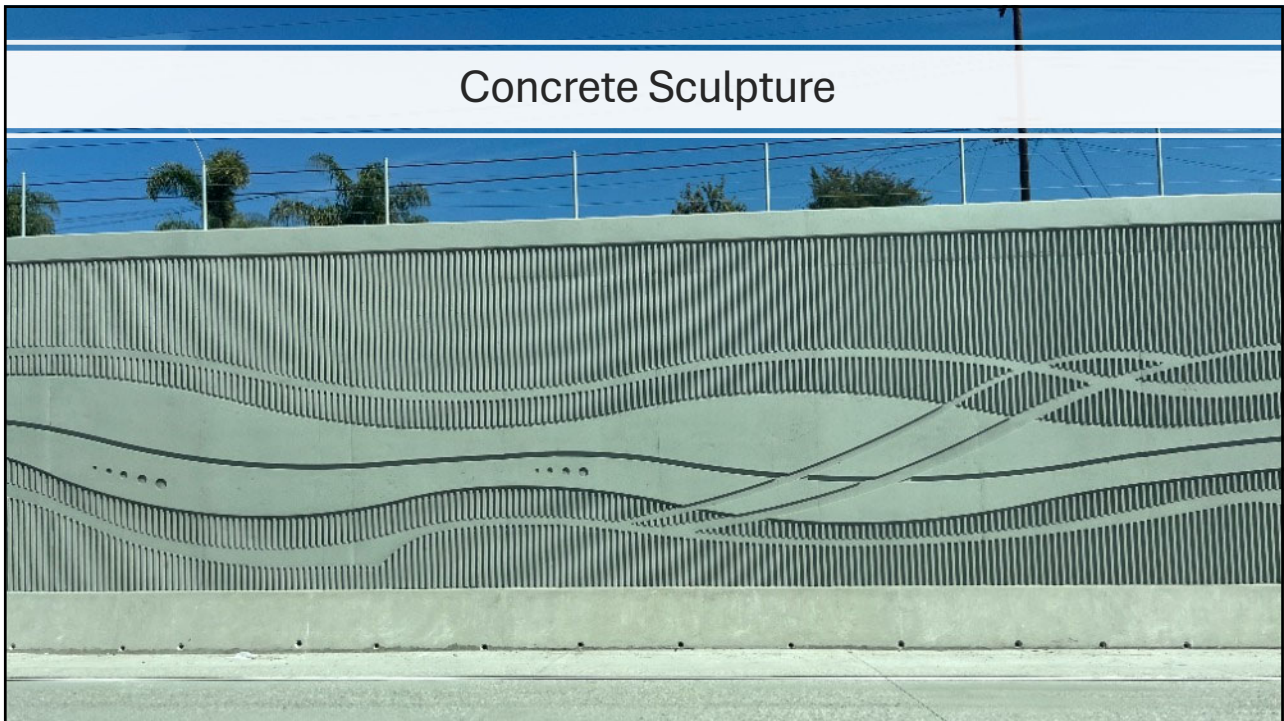


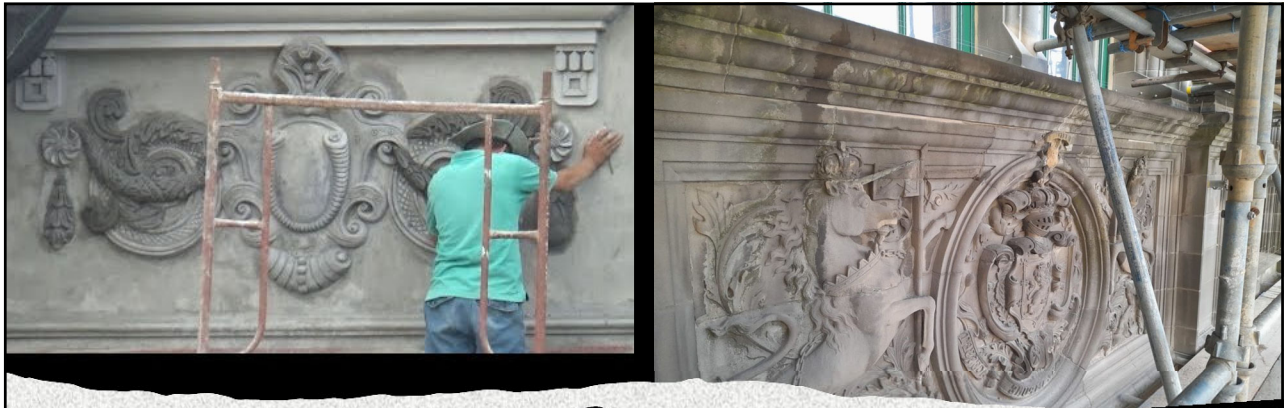

Tempe Arizona Public Art

- Tempe's Maryanne Corder Neighborhood Grant program was created in 1994 to invest in resident-initiated projects designed to enhance the quality of life in neighborhoods for all. This program cultivates opportunities for neighbors to commission artwork and other improvements that enhance community spaces. The art sites are inventive and sometimes unexpected: An irrigation standpipe serves as a backdrop for historical dialogue, and an entry wall is now a canvas for a metalworker. The Maryanne Corder Neighborhood Grant program is funded and run by the [Neighborhood Services Division](#) and supported by the Tempe Public Art program.

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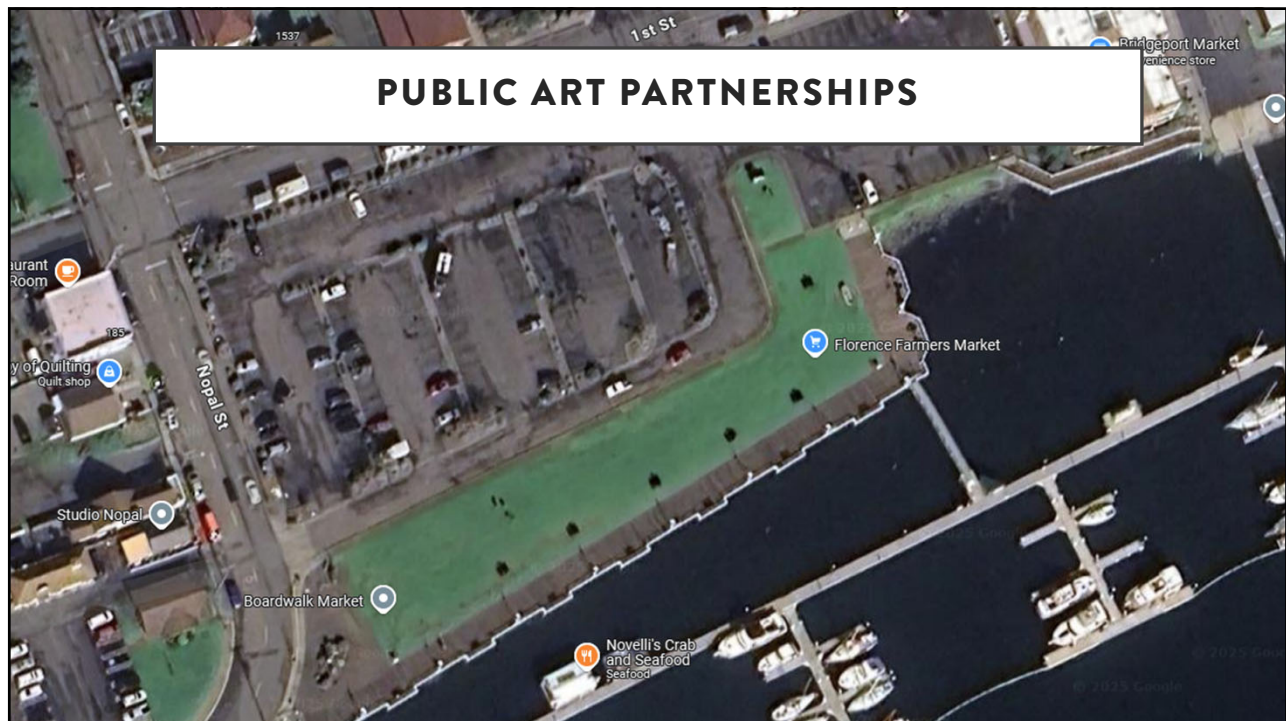
