I do not have any objections for cleaning the two sea lions under City control. I would reach out to OPB, Banner Bank and the Chamber to see if they would like some help/assistance with a gentle cleaning of the sea lions.

You might also bring up the topic with the Public Art Committee.



Lane Council of Governments (LCOG) celebrates walking communities each year with Walktober.


Last year, they worked with the City of Florence for the first time!

The Public Arts Committee and Transportation Committee led the Florence Art Walk on October 17.






