The State noted that Florence's water system facilities are well operated and maintained by a knowledgeable and competent staff."

As a water supplier, the City is required by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to provide an annual Consumer Confidence Report. Commonly known as a Water Quality Report, it provides water quality data from January 1st to December 31st, 2022. The report also informs customers of the location of the City's water sources, the City's source water protection programs, if there are any contaminants in the drinking water as well as the water analysis undertaken to ensure that the water delivered is safe and of the highest quality.

"Florence's dunal aquifer system is the only one of its kind in the State of Oregon," said Miller. "Protecting it and providing our residents with high quality drinking water is our top priority."

In addition to the legally required language, the 2022 version includes information regarding source water protection, fun and informative water facts, and a chart displaying daily water production.
