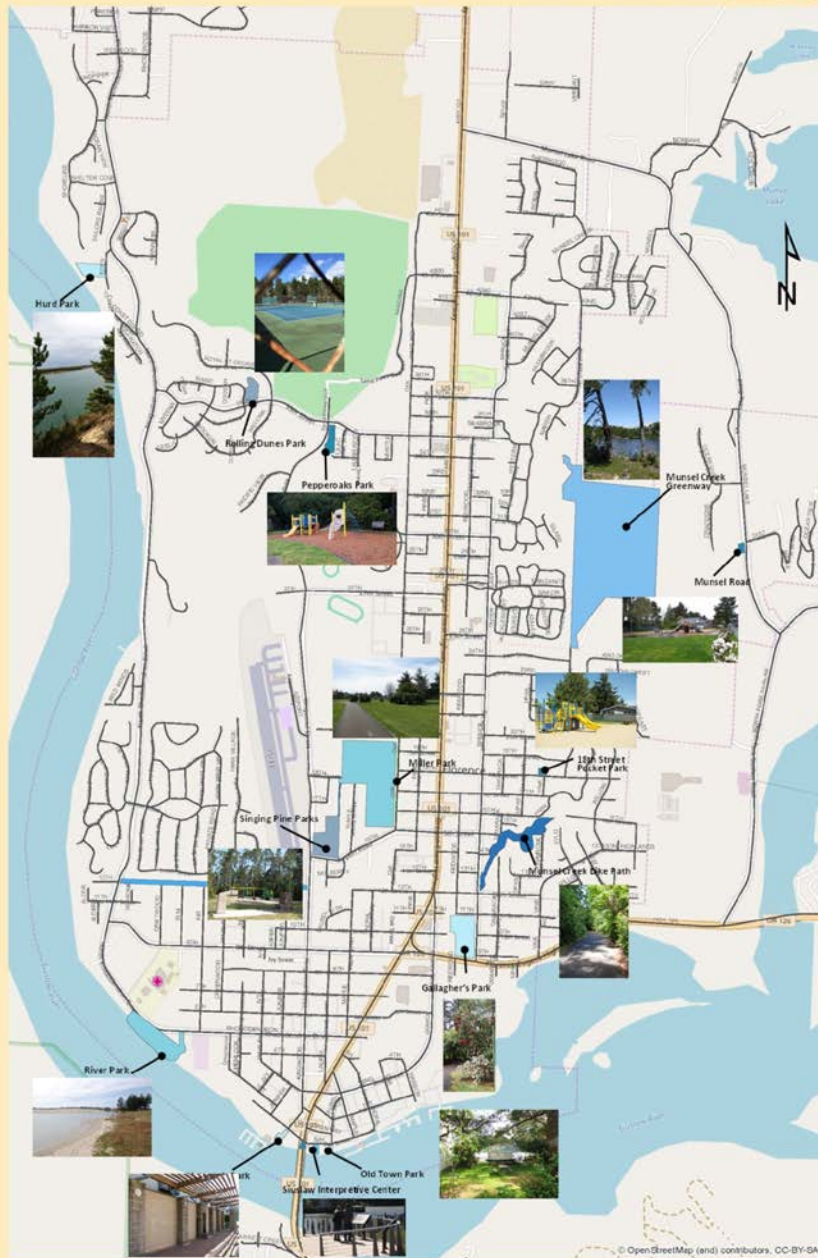


# Park System Map

## Mini Parks

- 18th Street Pocket Park with updated play area, a basketball court, and a picnic table.
- Pepperoaks Park has a new playset, basketball court, picnic area and benches.
- Munsel Road Park has playground area, basketball court and picnic area.

## Neighborhood Parks

- Singing Pines Park has a fenced dog park, small playground area and trails to Miller Park.
- Rolling Dunes Park has 2 tennis courts, pickleball and a picnic pavilion with a fire pit and restrooms.

## Special Use Parks

- Veteran's Park has wonderful views of the river and a place to contemplate and remember our veterans.
- Old Town Park is located on the site of the old ferry. The gazebo is used for events. See the City website
- Gallagher's Park is full of beautiful rhododendrons, walking paths, benches and picnic table.
- E.O. Hurd Memorial Park has a "hobbit trail" that ends at the river overlook. A great place for a sunset.
- Siuslaw Interpretive Area is in Old Town and has historical and estuary information as well as a stormwater treatment area.
- Maple Street Plaza is part of the Old Town area and is located at the south end of Maple on Bay Street. Restrooms are located here.
- River Park is soon to be completed and will have a picnic pavilion and trails to the river. This will also be a place to haul out a small boat for a picnic.

## Community Park

- Miller Park is a 20 acre park that has baseball fields, softball fields, basketball courts, soccer fields, skate park, playground and trails that are ADA.
