Residential Access

The project team will maintain residential access in the project area. Any temporary disruptions will be communicated with residents and the public.

What do you need to know?

Emergency Services Access

The project team will continue to work with Emergency Services to ensure they know the status of the construction area.

Access to the area for Emergency Services will be available throughout the project.

Business Access

The project team will work with the Lane County Transfer Station and the Oregon Coast Humane Society to maintain business access.

Any temporary disruptions will be communicated with businesses and the public.
