FLORENCE TRANSIT ADVISORY COMMITTEE MINUTES July 19, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 1:30 p.m. by Vice-Chair Patton.

ROLL CALL:

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: No quorum was present.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: No quorum was present.

ROUTE CHANGE UPDATE/OPERATIONS:

Ridership: No June ridership numbers were available at that time.

OTHER ITEMS:

<u>Wings and Wheels Debrief</u>: 160 riders, decrease from last year. Southerland opined that this might be a result of early morning cloud cover preventing a good showing of airplanes.

Medow stated that she found the signage lacking at the middle school parking lot in terms of showing where to park and where to board the bus, especially for people coming in at the south parking lot off of Oak Street. The boarding point was near the 27th Street parking lot entrance. Additional signage would be helpful in the future to allow more people to know about the service, where to park their own cars, and where to board the bus. Signage was increased 100% from last year.

<u>Florence/Yachats Connection</u>: Survey reported not working at LCC computer lab. Ahlen said he would look into the situation.

Public Art: No reportable progress. Public Art Committee still is working on art.

Bus Stop Adoption: Discussion delayed until the next meeting.

High School Student Member: No discussion.

<u>ADA Assessment of Bus \Stops</u>: – John offered to be a resource, if needed. There is an intern at City of Florence who is assessing accessibility.

New ADA service map announced extending 3/4 mile from route.

<u>New Bus Appearance</u>: TAC discussed the new bus, when that was scheduled to be delivered, and what the appearance of the bus would be – would like it to be "jazzed up." This is seen as an opportunity to market the bus service more broadly.

Dollar Store

First Friday at the Dollar Store Dollar store offers one free item

One Free Small Popcorn with purchase of movie ticket (Mondays are slow)

Coastal Fitness

Last Monday: Take a Splash at Coastal Fitness. A way of drawing in more users.

Home Grown

Last Tuesday to go along with Taco Tuesday (Free iced tea, or ½ off on taco)
