2. Verbal Testimony: Citizens wishing to express their views to the TC may participate in the meeting in person and via GoToWebinar. To do so, please complete a speaker's card online at https://www.ci.florence.or.us/bc-tc/transportation-committee-speakers-card at least 1 hour prior to the meeting. City staff will then contact the speaker to let them know the process to participate in the meeting.
a. Public Comments on items not on the agenda: General public comments (on items not on the agenda) will be allowed at each meeting during the public comment agenda item. Comments will be limited to three (3) minutes per person, with a maximum of 15 minutes for all items. In practicality, this means no more than five individuals will be allowed to comment verbally. There is no limit on written public comments.
b. Public Comments on Action Items: Public Comments will be allowed on each action item on the agenda. Verbal comments will be allowed on action items after staff has given their report and have allowed time for initial Committee questions. Comments will be limited to three (3) minutes per person, with a maximum of 15 minutes for all comments on each action item. In practicality, this means no more than five (5) individuals will be allowed to comment verbally. There is no limit on written public comments.
