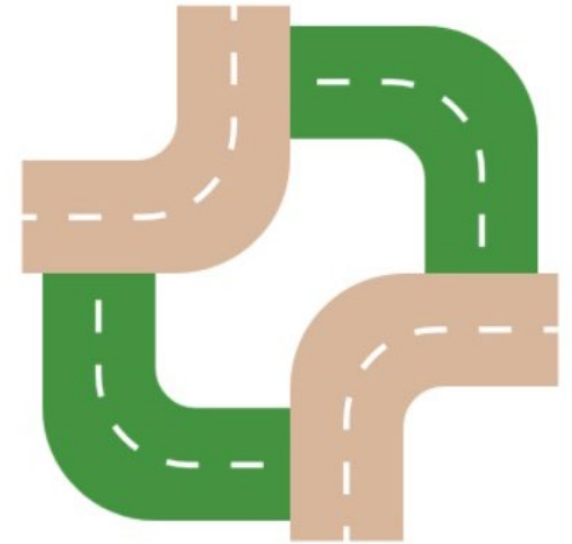

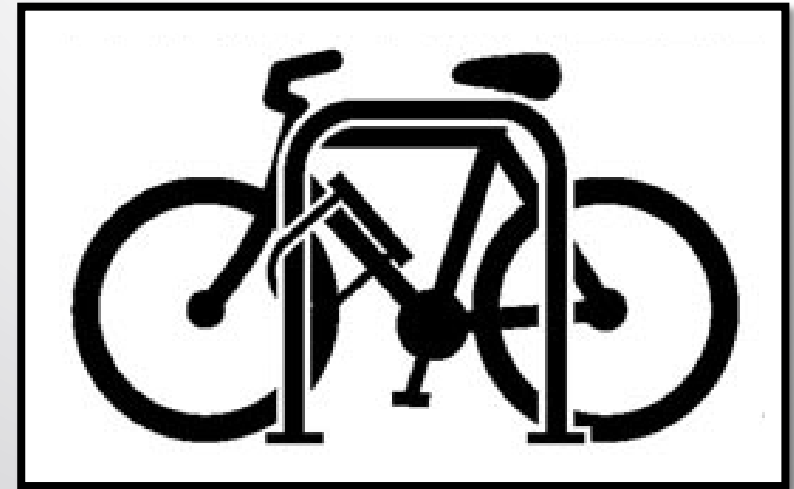
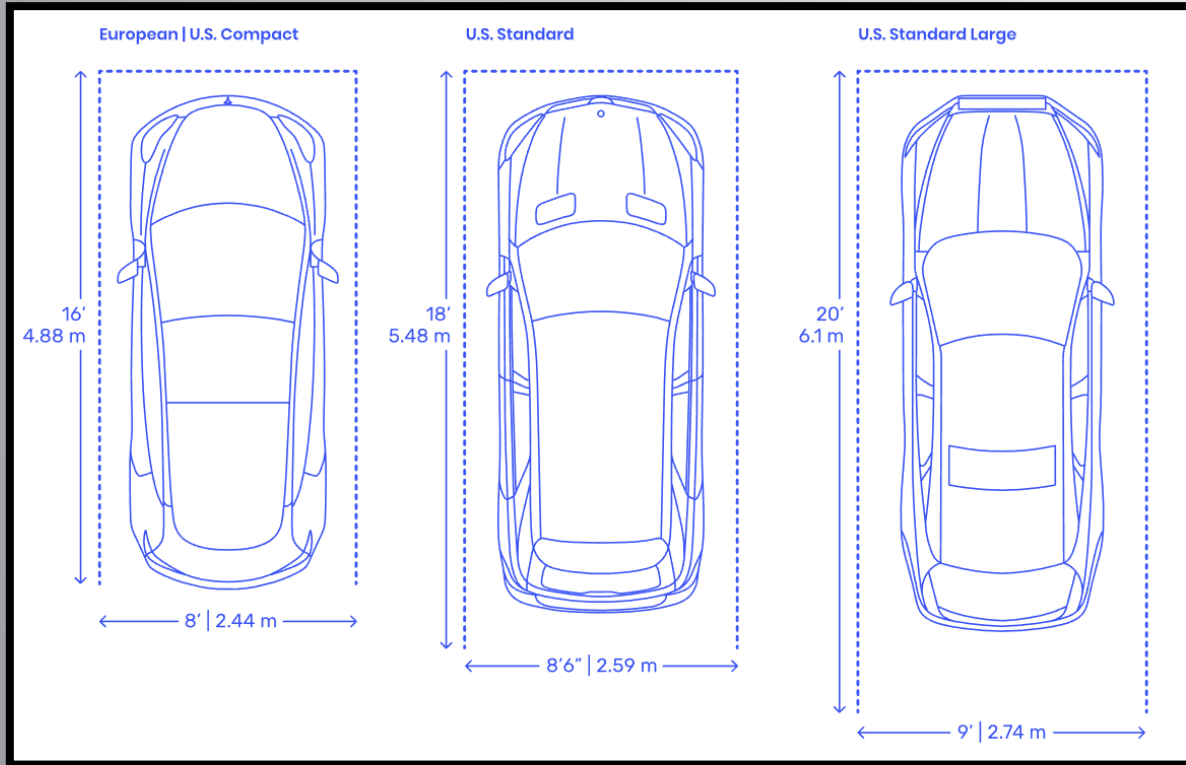

 - Bicycle parking- consistency with vehicle requirements

- **INFRASTRUCTURE & CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS**

- Pursue opportunities for EV charging at City facilities
- Siuslaw Estuary Trail – Hwy 126 to Port of Siuslaw Property
- Improve Parks and Trail Walkability
 - Major trail maintenance and repaving
 - Expansion of Exploding Whale Memorial Park
 - Look for Opportunities to expand park amenities Old Town
 - Look for Opportunities for add. Bike and walking trail amenities
