  - \*\* Note: Written comments received at least 2 hours prior to the meeting (May 13, 2021 at 3:30 p.m.) will be distributed to the Florence Urban Renewal Agency Budget Committee, posted to the City of Florence website, and made part of the record.
- 2. <u>Verbal Testimony:</u> Citizens wishing to express their views to the Florence Urban Renewal Agency Budget Committee may participate in the meeting via GotoWebinar.
